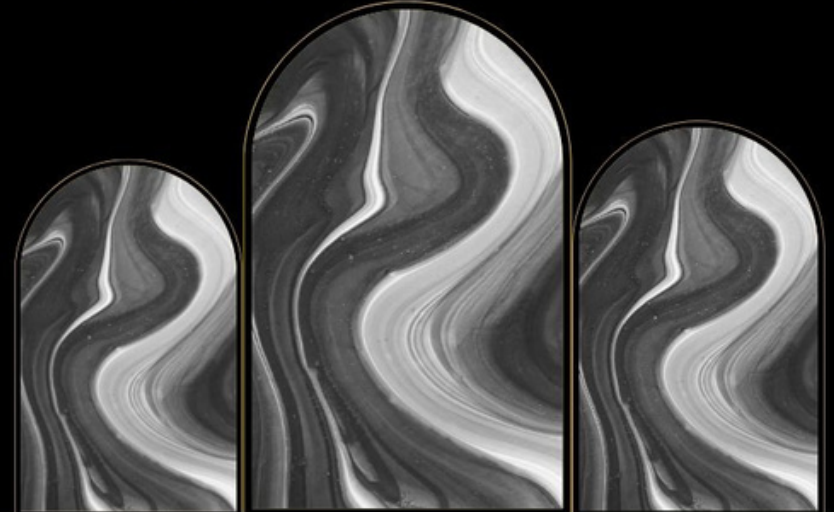

Corazon Stegelin (They/Them)- Director



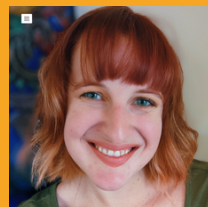
